LAW REPORTS ADMIRALTY DIVISION London. — United Africa Company, Limited, v. Owners of M.S. "Tolten". The plaintiffs, United Africa Company Limited, who own a wharf at Apapa in Lagos represented that the defendants' motor ship "Tolten", registered at Newport (Mon.), proceeding out of the harbour on October 13, last year, damaged a wharf and pier. No action for tort in respect of foreign land will lie in the Admiralty Courts, was the shipowners' objection. M. Justice today rejected the plea of demurrer and entered judgement for the plaintiffs on the preliminary point, with costs. In his judgement, his lordship, said, he found that the High Court of Admiralty was regarded as an international court, in this sense, that it exercised jurisdiction over foreign and British ships alike in respect of damage done or received by such ships, whether the damage had been done or received in British waters, or on the high seas or in foreign waters.

BRITISH OIL TANKERS TO BE LICENCED London. — A possible pointer to the form which the operation of British shipping generally will take in the early future was provided by a statement of the President of the Chamber of Shipping, M. H. F. Scherwater at a meeting of the Council (6.12.45) Owners of tankers, he said have been notified that they will be released from requisition as from the date on which vessels complete discharge after December 31 next, when their employment is to be subject to a licensing scheme the details of which are to be announced. Oil tankers were released from control by the United Maritime Authority on Oct. 31 last subject to certain qualifications until the end of this year, whereas the normal date for the release of dry tonnage by the Authority is March 2 next. The shipping industry is confident that it will not have to wait long now to learn what form of control, if any, the Government proposes to apply when requisitioning ceases, as at present arranged, early next year. The President recognised that while the Government has announced its intention not to nationalise either ocean-going or coast-wise shipping, the position of coast-wise shipping needs further clarification. Many of the vessels engaged in coast-wise services also participate in trades with the Continent. In view of the recent statement by the Minister of War Transport that pilotage is one of the services ancillary to shipping which needs examination, the Council agreed to remit consideration of a possible reorganization of the pilotage services to the Pilotage Committee, with a request that it should submit constructive proposals to the Council.

ANTWERP FRENCH TRANSIT PORT Antwerp. — Unconfirmed rumours are at present circulating in Belgian interested trade circles that Antwerp may become the large transit harbour for France. No confirmation of these rumours has been received, but according to Belgian press reports many cargoes arrived in Antwerp harbour for transhipment by barges etcetera to French ports. On the other hand there has been some competition in this field by Rotterdam harbour. Several ships have arrived lately there for transhipment to Strasbourg and Switzerland in the main. Meanwhile, several ships recently left Antwerp harbour for northern countries and South America.

SOUTHERN RAILWAY ORDERS CROSS-CHANNEL LINES London. — An important motorship contract has been given to a Scottish yard by the Southern Railway Company for a twin-screw cargo motorship for the cross-Channel service, primarily on the Southampton-Channel Islands route. It is nearly 20 years since new tonnage of cargo-liner type was added to the Southern Railway Company's fleet. Though few details are available, the ship herself is best described as being of the cross-Channel cargo-liner type, a type which is likely to become increasingly important as the development of air services takes place.
